Hi Andrew,

We are writing to voice our objection to renaming our portion of Montgomery St (Coalfields Hwy/Cameron St intersections). We have resided here in Allanson for 14 years with no problems with emergency services either the police or fire brigade when contacted to attend our address.

Who will bare the cost of having to change address with the many companies to contact?
I would like to refer you to a number of streets in the Collie /Allanson town sites that also run concurrent, Bedlington St/Railway Parade /Rose Rd Allanson all 1 road. In Wilson Park, Bickerton St that becomes Caulfield St that becomes Bessell Cres that becomes Cable St and then Bickerton St again, Irwin St becomes Telfer Cres which becomes Atkinson St then you must turn off Atkinson to continue on Telfer and it is the same for Atkinson in the reverse direction! Another good example is Jones St terminates as a cul de sac at Prinsep St (on the Eastern side of Prinsep St) then becomes Jones St again heading west. There are many more within Collie and obviously these are just a few.

With clear road signage with the correct street suffix & names, signs pointing in the correct direction emergency services wont have any problems identifying the houses in Montgomery St as they stand.

If you even got adventurous you could paint the house numbers kerbside in fluorescent colours or provide those green numbers that the rest of Allanson has and not Cameron or Montgomery that'll surely clear up any confusion since we do not have mail boxes at the front of our homes.

Good Morning Andrew,

We acknowledge the email provided by yourself from Mr and Mrs Broadbent.

Our reasoning for suggesting the changes within this area were clearly outlined previously by both Tracey Vance and myself.

It will need to be conveyed to Mr and Mrs Broadbent that whether their road name changes or not they will still need to change their addresses as currently their addressing is running out of sequence and in the wrong direction for Montgomery Street.

We suggested bringing the name Cameron around the corner to meet with Coalfields Road for logical continuity of numbers and flow. The two portions of Montgomery are doglegged and do not flow. From our investigations there is no street signage indicating that this section of road is call Montgomery.

Ultimately the decision lies with Council as to whether they are willing to accept the future liability and risk by accepting the reasons given by Mr and Mrs Broadbent as sufficient argument for not changing road name and addresses.

Please advised when Council have made their decision. In the mean time we will progress with renaming of the north eastern section of Montgomery as requested and we will also unname the portion which is through the school.
