### **BUSH FIRE BRIGADES AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2018**

Under the powers conferred by the *Bush Fires Act 1954*, the *Local Government Act 1995* and under all other powers enabling it, the Council of the Shire of Collie resolved on 17 April 2018 to make the following local law.

#### 1. Citation

This local law may be cited as the *Shire of Collie Bush Fire Brigades Amendment Local Law 2018*.

#### 2. Commencement

This local law comes into operation 14 days after the date of its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

### 3. Principal local law

This local law amends the *Shire of Collie Bush Fire Brigades Local Law 2017* as published in the *Government Gazette* on 21 July 2017.

## **4.** Clause **1.2**(1) amended

In clause 1.2(1) in the definition for *Rules* delete "as varied from time to time under clause 2.5".

#### 5. Schedule 1 amended

Schedule 1 is amended as follows –

- (a) in clause 1.1(2) in the definition of *local law* after "Law" insert "2017";
- (b) in clause 2.3(d) delete "LG" and replace with "local government";
- (c) in clause 2.6 delete "Department of Fire and Emergency Services" and replace with "Department";
- (d) in clause 2.11(c) delete "clause 2.8(1)" and insert "clause 2.8(2)";
- (e) in clause 3.8(h) delete "CBFCO" and insert "Chief Bush Fire Control Officer";
- (f) in clause 4.2(5) delete "ne" and insert "be";
- (g) after clause 7.5 insert:

### **7.6 Fees**

- (1) The membership fees, if any, for each type of member for the ensuing 12 months are to be determined by the bush fire brigade at the annual general meeting.
- (2) Subject to subclause (3), a member is to pay the membership fees for his or her type of membership on or before 31 March.
- (3) The bush fire brigade may exempt a brigade member, or a class of membership, from the payment of membership fees, for such period and on such conditions as the bush fire brigade may determine.
