

COLLIE CBD ARTISTIC REVITALISATION

VISION & BACKGROUND

The Shire of Collie completed an extensive CBD upgrade in 2017 through the support of Royalties for Regions, Lotterywest and Bendigo Bank. The project has been recognised through winning both state and national Planning Institute Awards.

The Shire of Collie is now seeking volunteers who are interested in forming a group to consider and implement several artistic initiatives in the Collie CBD. The Group will be assisted by Council staff.

The Forrest Street alcove mural will be the first project to consider for the group. The aim of this project is to develop some interactive artwork which will draw visitors into Collie's CBD area.

KEY OBJECTIVES

- To develop a range of interesting and interactive artwork in several public places within the Collie CBD to complement the recently completed improvements to the CBD.
- To enliven and brighten the Collie CBD with a range of themed artwork, commencing with the Forrest st “alcove project” selfie wall
- To consider the use of social media in the design of any artwork.

BUDGET

To assist the group, the Council will provide seed funding of **\$1500 excluding GST** to cover all costs involved in the completion of the artwork. The materials used for this artwork must be of suitable quality to withstand outdoor conditions.
