

## Shire of Collie Application for Sporting Scholarship

## **Council Policy for Sporting Scholarships, main objectives are:**

Purpose: To financially assist by way of covering out-of-pocket expenses, for local sporting individuals who have been selected in a Western Australian State or Australian National representative team.

- 1. Assistance will be provided as a sporting scholarship of \$250.
- 2. A single application must be made where three or more residents are selected to participate in the same team and must be accompanied by the requirements of Item 4 for team members named in the application. The maximum able to be granted to the group is \$500.
- 3. Assistance provided within any one calendar year can span more than one sport but the individual claiming cannot in any case receive more than \$250 within the one calendar year.
- 4. All applications must be accompanied by a statement or authorisation from the relevant state or national sporting organisation confirming team selection.
- 5. Applicants may re-apply in subsequent years should their selection be ongoing.
- 6. Application must be received at the Shire prior to the team participating in the relevant competition and cannot be made retrospectively for past team selections.
- 7. Nothing in this policy is to be construed as to infer that there is an automatic right of any individual to receive financial assistance.
