

CCTV UPGRADE FOR COLLIE

Collie residents can soon feel much safer, following the completion of the first stage of a major upgrade of the Shire of Collie's CCTV network, with more work planned over the next two financial years. Stage one was funded by the State CCTV Strategy and provided improved communications and video management systems. New fixed cameras were installed in Throssell Street giving the Collie Police the capability of reading the number plates of vehicles passing through the town. Additionally, a solar powered mobile unit was delivered to the Collie Police Station for deployment to identified locations with CCTV vision sent directly to police mobile phones.

Following a successful application to the Federal Safer Communities a comprehensive upgrade of all CCTV infrastructure in the Collie CBD will be implemented over the next eighteen months. This funding will allow for nearly 40 additional cameras to be installed in the town centre giving coverage for the area bounded Medic and Throssell Streets, and Prinsep and Lefroy Streets."

We know residents are concerned about their safety," Shire President Sarah Stanley said. "This project will go a long way to helping police combat crime, sending a strong message that our community will not tolerate illegal activity." "We welcome the support of the state and federal government in funding this much-needed infrastructure for our community," Cr Stanley said.

"The new cameras are a significant asset for the community in the fight against crime", CEO David Blurton said. "The vision quality of the new cameras is excellent and this should allow police to investigate incidents and identify suspects with greater certainty." he added. While the planning undertaken by the Shire in 2019 in consultation with the Police and CCTV consultants included the approach roads to Collie and public facilities outside the CBD, this work has not yet been funded. Shire staff will continue to seek funding and work towards CCTV projects that deliver a safer community for the residents of Collie.

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

PROCUREMENT OF OLD TIMBER FLOORING FROM MINOR SPORTS HALL AT ROCHE PARK

The Shire of Collie invites expressions of interest from not-for-profit community groups and associations located within the Shire of Collie for procurement of approximately 600m2 of used timber strip flooring and associated joists to the minor sports hall at Roche Park Recreation Centre.

Submissions can be made for all, or a quantity of, the used timber floor. The timber sections are comprised of 19mm thick by 60mm wide jarrah tongue and groove floor boards, top nailed to 40mm x 60mm wide hardwood joists.

The used flooring being the subject of this EOI will be cut into 1900 x 1900mm sections (comprising the tongue and groove boards still nailed to the joists) by the contractor carrying out flooring replacement works, being Aura Sports Pty Ltd, and removed from within the minor sports hall at Roche Park Recreation Centre.

The contractor will place these sections on end into bins ready for transportation in a location external to the building, with works commencing on the 10 August 2020. The contractor can transport bins to a successful tenderers location. The successful tender/s will be responsible for removing the 1900 x 1900mm sections from the bin and any additional charges if bins need to be cleaned out/emptied after removal of timber sections. Bins will need to be returned to site once flooring is removed. Submissions made can be for all, or a quantity of the old timber floor and are to include:

Name of user group or association responsible for the submission;

Intended purpose for the 1900 x 1900 sections of timber; and

Method of removing the stacked of flooring to ensure Worksafe obligations are met.

No cost bids are required to be included with submissions.
