



Parks & Gardens Supervisor

The Shire of Collie is seeking a motivated, suitably qualified and enthusiastic Parks & Gardens Supervisor to lead the Parks & Gardens team.

Key responsibilities of the position will include:

- Provide hands-on leadership, guidance and daily supervision to Parks & Gardens staff.
- Plan, schedule and oversee maintenance programs across parks, gardens, reticulation, playgrounds and landscape assets.
- Work closely with the Leading Hand to deliver quality outcomes and support team performance.
- Manage plant, equipment, materials, budgets and project costings.
- Coordinate contractors and liaise with internal and external stakeholders.
- Drive safety, compliance and continuous improvement within the team.

To succeed in this role, you should ideally hold a Certificate IV in Horticulture or equivalent experience, strong leadership and staff supervision capabilities, and proven skills in budgeting, project costing and resource allocation.

The successful candidate will have strong communication and leadership skills, be confident using a range of computer applications and demonstrate sound knowledge of turf management and sportsground maintenance. A current MR Class Driver's Licence is required. Previous Parks and Gardens supervisory experience, project management skills, and knowledge of local government will be highly regarded.

An attractive remuneration package up to \$98,000 will be offered based on skills and experience, with a base cash salary of up to \$85,000 plus allowances, including commuter use of a motor vehicle.
